



**POLICY: ACTIVITY AND COURSE COST FEES – SECONDARY
STUDENT**

REFERENCE NO: P-BA-29

Activity Fees:

The standard student activity fee is \$50 and is used to supplement a student's school experience through activities and materials that are optional. Any change to this fee will be developed in consultation with the school community and approved by the Director of Education.

The revenue in each school resulting from the student activity fees will be allocated by the school Principal to provide funding for extracurricular activities and athletics, student council activities, yearbooks for students and other student activities. Examples of activities that may be subsidized include school clubs, dances, prom, theme days, graduation, school awards, etc.

Principals will clearly communicate a discreet and respectful process for activity and course fees to be waived or subsidized if the student/parent/guardian is experiencing financial hardship.

Where a student does not pay the activity fee or have it waived by the Principal, this student will not be eligible to participate in these types of activities.

Course Cost Fees:

Fees may be charged where a student chooses to upgrade the materials or where the purchase of materials is optional. It is recognized that there may be optional resources that students may purchase to enhance the program. Students must be allowed to participate in the regular day school program without fees or costs charged to them.

Accountability to the School Community:

Fees should reflect the estimated cost of the services or materials provided to the student.
