



OUTBREAK COMMUNITY MEMO

Date: November 9, 2021

This letter is to notify you that under the direction of the Medical Officer of Health, the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) has declared a cohort outbreak in the 5P class, effective November 8, 2021.

As per provincial Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education guidance, an outbreak is declared once it has been determined that two individuals have tested positive with an epidemiological link (e.g. these children/staff could have become infected with COVID-19 at school, from either each other or a common source).

Any children that were part of this cohort have been directed to self-isolate until they are cleared to return to school by the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU).

To protect against COVID-19:

- Wash hands more often with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Cover your cough and/or sneeze with a tissue or sleeve
- Maintain 2 metres physical distancing between yourself and others
- Wear a mask or face coverings
- Stay home when you are sick
