This letter is to notify you know of a high-risk exposure case of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) in our school community. The Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) has not recommended any further action at the school level.

Please continue to monitor yourself or your child for symptoms of COVID-19 each morning by using the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 Screening Tool. If you or your child is ill, please remain at home and call your health care provider for further direction. People with COVID-19 may have little to no symptoms; some symptoms are similar to the common cold or flu. Symptoms range from mild to severe. The most common symptoms include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Change in smell or taste

COVID-19 spreads from close contact with the respiratory droplets of a person infected with the virus. Respiratory droplets can be released into the air by coughing, sneezing, talking, and normal breathing. It is possible for a person to get the COVID-19 by touching surfaces that have the virus on it and then touching their mouth, nose, or eyes.

To protect against COVID-19:

- Wash hands more often with soap and water or use an alcohol based hand sanitizer
- Cover your cough and/or sneeze with a tissue or sleeve
- Maintain 2 metres physical distancing between yourself and others
- Wear a mask or face coverings
- Stay home when you are sick
