School Climate Survey - Jon Procter

- General results of the school climate survey were provided through a powerpoint presentation.
- Results were correlated into key areas: School Culture, Diversity, Wellness, Bullying and Parental Perspective.
- In general, school is considered to be a welcoming place as noted by both parents and students. Parents feel that parents and volunteers are a vital part of school culture.
- Overall, most students think bullying is being addressed. They feel that bullying is occurring during less structured times such as lunch and spare. Students indicated that they do not want to get involved when they witness bullying.
- Grade 7-12 students report that the plans after high school emphasize the pathway to university. Teachers are doing a good job at talking about the different pathways in high school.
- Parents are looking for schools to communicate how parents are able to help within the school. Response to the School Climate Survey by parents was very low.
- Next Steps
 - Individual schools have their results to incorporate into their own school improvement plan.
 - Board results have been distributed to committees.
 - Superintendents have the results.
 - Staff survey will be conducted this year.
 - Results are posted on the Board website as well as individual school sites.
