- School Climate Survey created by the board to take the temperature of schools and look for ways to improve
- Focused on bullying and mental health, safe learning environment
- survey and results are located on the board website
- very few secondary parents filled out the survey, many possible reasons, language barrier being one.

- 2 requests of GECPIC: 1) some support to figure out how to have greater number of surveys filled out. 2) Feedback regarding reducing the number of questions on survey

Chair's Report - *Jamie del'Eveille*

- Chair spoke to the motion brought forward by the Board of Trustees stating a concern regarding making principals feel obligated to come to a meeting
- Director Kelly spoke to the motion stating a feeling of protection over the principals and adding to their work load
- Trustee McKinley spoke to the motion ensuring members understood that the motion was brought forward by one trustee, not the entire Board and expressed that she never felt mandated to come but always came when invited. With advance notice, more Trustees would come to meetings

- Beverlee Lachine seconded it.
- Vote was held: unanimous
- Jamie referenced Bullying Week, highlighting Walkerville's play
- Announced that the PIC ledger was not attached to the agenda and previous minutes as it should be.
