



## REGULATION: Safe Schools

REFERENCE NO: R-AD-16

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The Provincial Code of Conduct, the Greater Essex County District School Board Code of Conduct, the Greater Essex County District School Board Safe Schools Policy, the Education Amendment Act (Progressive Discipline and School Safety), 2007, and the Education Amendment Act (Keeping our Kids Safe at School), 2009, create expectations for behaviour for all persons on school property.

Pursuant to the Education Act, Principals are required to maintain proper order and discipline in schools, and pupils are responsible to their Principals for their conduct and are required to accept such discipline as would be exercised by reasonable, kind, firm and judicious parents/guardians.

### **POLICE- SCHOOL BOARD PROTOCOL**

- a) The Greater Essex County District School Board endorses the work of the Police-School Board Liaison Committee in its development of the local Police-School Board Protocol.
  
- b) The Local Police-School Board Protocol document located in each school's Safe Schools binder shall guide school Principals in investigations requiring police consultation or response.
