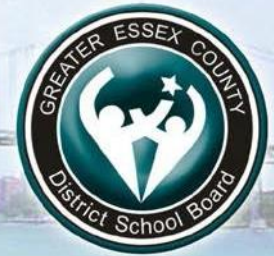

Required Documents:

Please collect all documents prior to applying. Each document must be scanned individually as a PDF less than 5 MB each. Online applications must be completed and submitted within 30 days.

1. A copy of the passport with photo and identifying information. The passport **MUST** be valid for a minimum of 6 months upon arrival to Canada.
2. Transcripts or report cards for the last 2 years translated into English;
3. Immunization records translated into English;
4. Mandatory Student Participation Agreement;
5. Custodianship Declaration. All International Students unaccompanied by a parent **MUST** provide a Custodianship Declaration. The custodian must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident, 25 year or older, live full-time in the Windsor area and be present in the Windsor area for the duration of the student's enrollment in the GECD SB.

Application Procedures

The application deadline for September is June 1. The application deadline for February is December 1.

- Submit the online [application](#) form in full. Incomplete applications will result in a delay or decline of the application. If homestay is required, indicate this on the application and an MLI Homestay application will be emailed.
- Pay the application fee.
- A confirmation email will be sent with the invoice and payment instructions.
- Pay tuition and medical insurance fees. Payment is due 30 days prior to the start of the program. Payment can be made by certified cheque, bank draft or wire transfer.
- Upon acceptance, a Letter of Acceptance and a Letter of Accommodation will be issued to the contact person. These are required to make an application for a Study Permit, obtained from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada.
- Apply for a [Study Permit](#). In most cases, applicants now need to provide fingerprints and a digital photo ([biometrics](#)).
- Upon acceptance, the Visa will issued by mail or email. The Study Permit will be issued upon landing in Canada at Canada Customs.
- Write the Vital English and Math online assessments. An email will be sent with a link to the online assessments.
- Email a copy of the Study Permit to international@publicboard.ca promptly when it is received.

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
