Regulations: Trustee Pregnancy/Parental/Adoption and Infant/Child Care Leave

Reference No: R-GV-10

Definitions

Trustee: An individual who is a member of the Board within the meaning of the Education Act. This applies to all current elected school board members and student trustees.

Board and committee meetings are not the only time commitment for trustees. Other responsibilities include:

- 1. Attending community meetings as a representative of the school board.
- 2. Communications responding to the concerns of parents and others (i.e. telephone calls or emails, meeting requests and queries from constituents).

Trustee Leave Notification Considerations:

- 3. The Trustee will notify the board as soon as reasonably possible to inform it regarding an upcoming leave.
- 4. The Trustee will indicate the purpose for the leave: trustee pregnancy, birth of a member's child, the adoption of a child by the member or infant/child care leave.
- 5. The Trustee will provide an expected date the leave is to begin and conclude provided the leave does not exceed 20 consecutive weeks and begins no later than the date of a third consecutively missed regular board meeting.
- 6. The Trustee will provide relevant medical documentation (this could include medical certificates confirming pregnancy, proof of birth date, or adoption agency statements).
- 7. Trustee Honoraria for base and enrolment amounts continue to be provided during the leave period. During the period of their leave, the trustee would resign from positions of added responsibility (i.e. Chair, Vice-Chair and any additional committees). The Board shall appoint a trustee to the position of added responsibility. Any additional honoraria with respect to that position of added responsibility will go to the newly appointed trustee for the period of the leave.
- 8. Relevant Trustee expenses will continue to be reimbursed (i.e. cellphone, computer).
- 9. The Trustee will continue to receive board-related material and have access to information during the leave.
- 10. The Trustee will also consider the following:
 - Whether or not they will continue to participate in board/committee meetings, either in person or via electronic means in accordance with Regulation: Electronic Meetings and Meeting Attendance; and
 - ➤ How they intend to notify their community about their leave, and how the community will be supported during the leave.
