Belle River District High School: Scholarship & Bursary Ideas


There is no right or wrong way to search for scholarship opportunities. It takes time and organization to apply to scholarships & bursaries. Here are some suggestions to help you.

- 1. Start a file with your applications. Once you've created some answers and asked for some reference letters, you will likely be able to use them (or parts of them) for many applications.
- 2. Don't wait. Start now. If you wait until June to start, it will likely be very difficult to earn scholarship money.
- 3. Check out your College or University's website. Most information about Entrance Scholarships and other scholarships/ bursaries are found there. It's an excellent resource.
- 4. Consider signing up for a scholarship data bank service to help with your search. Even if they are not all a match for you, it may still be helpful. (Some examples found below).
- 5. Be sure you always check your spelling and grammar before submitting your application.

Note: The following scholarships are a sample of possible scholarships and certainly not a complete list. Do not hesitate to use all resources available to you and continue to conduct research on your own. Speak with a Guidance Counsellor for help anytime!



- Do your research!
- Take the time necessary to complete each scholarship's application process
- Gather the necessary documents. Get transcripts from Guidance (48 hours' notice please). Give ample notice to anyone from whom you request a reference letter (providing them with some key points about you and your accomplishments can make their task easier)
- Respect each application's DEADLINE!!!!
- Be sure to check to see if there are different protocols or timelines due to Covid.
