#### Fundraising Updates - S.Slipiec

October Pasta Lunch Results – Rosa's worked out very well. We had 190 orders so 4 trays were ordered. There was extra leftover so some was sent home with some families. Serving utensils will need to be purchased as the ones we brought over at the beginning of the year have disappeared. Stephanie will take care of this.

Serving went well today. The lunches were given out to the Primary students first. Students from the portables had to come inside and go up the stairs to get their pasta. The garlic knots were a hit too.

Fresh from the Farm – This did not do well. The biggest issue was the timing and sharing of the information. There was not enough talk about it. Only sold 9 bundles of apples and 20 bundles of vegetables. Minimum order is 20 bundles of each. So they are going to purchase the minimum order and use it with the snack program. Profit was \$218. Expenses were \$224 after ordering the bundles.

Hot lunch communications to school community (teachers & parents) – Some staff are not aware of the food days. Some parents are not hearing about this either. Amanda has an idea, let staff be included on the School Cash online. Adding the date into the title of the Food Items. Teachers will receive a copy of the Fundraising Template.

42 orders were added to provide students in need with a hot lunch.

The Food Day dates will be added to the River of News to inform parents of them.

Stephanie will update the spreadsheet template. She will post the information on the Parent Facebook Page. Bonnie made a few revisions as well.

Loonie License Day will be shared with different classes. When the Grade 8s organize they get the funds. When other classes do this, the classes will get 80% and the school will receive 20%. Teachers will post on Edsby the privileges that each class can participate in. The first day is November 21, 2023. One loonie for one privilege or \$5 for everything.

What's Poppin was used for the school funds. Sports expenses such as cabs or referees will be used for this.

Snack Program Progress Update - S.Slipiec - Good system set up. Good flow. Lots of help. 50% fruit, 50% grain. Apples, Bananas, Melba Toast, Granola Bars, Cheerios, stock has been adjusted for the school. Approximately \$800 per month. Expectation of "Nutritional Activities" to be shared with the students. Students are receiving a snack 5 days a week and there is a team of students who are picking up the bins at the end of the day. Also applied to the WECHU for a Food Handling and Cooking Program. This is an 8-week program. We are also in need of Pasta Lunch Supplies.

PRO Grant – Funding has changed this year. It is there and it is accessible. Talking for a PRO Grant. Do we want to work with other schools to make the event bigger?
