

## Grade 9 Course Selection Instructions

Grade 9 students must choose 6 compulsory credits and 2 electives. Compulsory courses are those that a student must take in order to graduate. The compulsory courses are listed below followed by their respective course codes.

English	ENL1W, ENG1L
French	FSF1DC, FSF1OC, *FEF1DC (*French Immersion students only)
Canadian Studies – Geography^	CGC1W^ (^French Immersion students will take History)
Canadian Studies – History	*CHC2DF (*French Immersion students only)
Mathematics	MTH1W, MTH1WN, MAT1L
Science	SNC1W, SNC1L
Physical Education	PPL1OM (male), PPL1OF (female)

- MTH1W, SNC1W, ENL1W, CGC1W & FSF1DC are de-streamed courses replacing academic and applied courses.
- Locally developed (L), and enriched Mathematics (MTH1WN) courses should only be chosen upon a recommendation of the grade 8 teacher.
- After selecting the 6 required courses, please select two elective courses from the list below.

Visual Arts	AVI1O
Drama	ADA1O
Technology and the Skilled Trades	TAS1O
Food and Nutrition	HFN1O
Business	BEM1O
