The EarlyON Child and Family Centres provide services that support all families in Windsor-Essex with children ages 0-6 years. The Centres can connect you to local programs and services for children.

EarlyON Child and Family Centres provide free programs that:

- Support early learning and development by offering in-person and virtual programming to encourage children's learning through play, and to build positive child adult relationships;
- Engage parents and caregivers through information sharing about child development, parenting, play, and inquiry based learning;
- Offer pre and post natal support;
- Connect families to the community by responding to parents and caregivers inquiring about their child's development. This can include offering screening, making referrals to health professionals or other specialized community services.
