Description and condition of playground equipment:

School has a number of playground pieces

Has one large composite playground, one independent slide, one challenge climber and one large swing set structure manufactured by Paris Playgrounds and was installed approximately 1999. The play structures have two slides, a bridge fireman pole, climber net, swing set and overhead climber. This play structure is designed for 5 years to 12 years of age. Playground equipment requires a number of repairs and the swing set will be removed as it is unsafe. The surfacing requires to topping up and the remaining equipment requires a number of repairs which the school is reviewing based on cost and play value.

The equipment and surfacing are in an acceptable condition.

One large play structure manufactured by Hilan Creative Play structures back in 1990. The play structure is designed for 18 months to 12 years of age. The play structure is primarily made of wood and has two slides and stair case to platform. The structure requires a number of repairs and based on age and cost to repair and replace surfacing should be removed. Discussions are underway on future of this equipment.
