

Description and condition of playground equipment:

School has a number of pieces of playground equipment:

- a) One large composite play structure with one slide, a chain link wall climber, one Tube bridge, and one overhead hand climber is manufactured by Paris Playground equipment. The play structure is designed for 5 years to 12 years of age. The structure was installed\ designed in 1998. The structure requires many repairs and the surfacing requires replacement these costs may be prohibitive and the outcome should be to remove this piece of equipment.
- b) Three pieces of exercise equipment, one infinity climber manufactured by Little Tykes Commercial Play Systems (2007), one composite play structure manufactured by Paris Playground(1998) and a wood balance beam. Structures are designed to challenge student's physical abilities similar to an obstacle course. The composite play structure requires a number of repairs and the surfacing replaced which may be cost prohibitive for the school. May want to consider removal. The infinity play structure is in very good shape however the surfacing requires replacement at school cost.
