Play Equipment #1 is a small composite play structure with 4 play platforms (105, 105, 118, 135 cm heights), 1 staircase, 1 platform climber, 2 standard rail panels, 4 platform panels, 1 roof, 1 straight slide, 1 curved slide, and wood engineered wood fibre surfacing and designed for ages 18 months to 12 years of age. The structure was installed by Active Playground Equipment in 2002 and is in good condition.

Play Equipment # 2 is a composite play structure with 7 play platforms (2 x 50, 2 x 137, 163, 2 x 198 cm heights), 1 staircase, 1 bridge, 1 rung ladder,

1 composite play structure 2 platform climbers, 1 pole climber, 4 standard rail panels, 1 platform panel, 1 ground-level panel, 1 climbing wall, 2 straight slides. The equipment was installed in 2002 by Active Playground Equipment and is designed for ages 5 years to 12 months of age. The play equipment and surfacing is in good condition.
