Report of a meeting held in the gym. at Tecumseh Vista Academy



At the January 15, 2013, regular meeting of the Board, Trustees approved the following recommendation regarding the Tecumseh Family of Schools:

PROGRAM DELIVERY.**

1. Call to Order and Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Superintendent Lyons. He thanked everyone for their attendance. This is our final community meeting in the process. The committee will present their final report this evening. They will then present their report to the Board on Wednesday evening of this week, at 6:30 p.m. at a Special Meeting of the Board.

Once the PARC presents its report to trustees on June 19, the report will sit for 60 days. During that time, the Director of Education analyses the committee's report, writes his own report and submits recommendations to Trustees.

Trustees vote and make the final decision, probably in the Fall of 2013, and implementation will not take place before September 2014. Trustees are the only group of people making decisions, the PARC committee acts in an advisory capacity.

Minutes of all meetings are posted on the board website.

2. Introductions

Some introductions were made: Chairperson of the Board, Helga Bailey, Trustees Cheryl Lovell and Connie Buckler and Area Superintendent of Education, Pyke. Public Relations Officer, Scott Scantlebury was also introduced.

3. Presentation

Members of the committee, Mr. Wayne Samwell, Ms. Shelley Hodare, Ms. Diana Fratarcangeli, parent representatives, shared a powerpoint presentation with the audience.

The Chairperson of the Committee, Wayne Samwell noted that the committee initially developed 18 proposals that have been evaluated carefully by the committee to arrive at the final two recommendations which are being presented this evening.

He thanked the community for their valuable input.

Mr. Samwell began the presentation and gave a general outline of the process to date.

Mrs. Fratarcangeli took over and reviewed enrolment projection data.

Superintendent Lyons interjected and explained the slide depicting the student distribution of French Immersion students at Tecumseh Vista Academy. The majority of the French Immersion populations is from west of Banwell Road. Questions have been raised about the large French Immersion boundary; the slide shows that only a handful of students reside south of County Road 42.

Mrs. Fratarcangeli continued. She presented enrolment data for all the schools and outlined the final recommendations and then reviewed the narrative for the boundary adjustments.

Mrs. Hodare completed the presentation. Pictorial slides of the new proposed boundaries were displayed. She continued with the proposed boundary adjustments. She then presented slides that outlined the enrolment data for the schools should the proposal move forward.

4. Collection of Community Input

Superintendent Lyons especially thanked the committee for all their hard work and noted that it is not easy to present in front of the community. The only voting members on the committee are parents and community members. He added that although the committee has been working very hard they felt they would like an opportunity to have conversations with members of the community and so a different format is being used this evening. Committee representatives from each school are available at the respective tables. He too, will be available to answer questions. Cards were made available for comments and someone at each table recorded questions and comments as appropriate.

All comments will be added to the minutes of the meeting as an attachment.

It is recognized that there were a lot of unhappy people at the last meeting, but requested that people please not make derogatory comments about other schools. There are parents and students in those schools, too, who feel exactly as positive about that school as you do about yours. Please be respectful of everyone.

Superintendent Lyons then clarified the term "limited exception."

In this particular instance it means that whatever child is in attendance in the school at that time, that child will be allowed to remain, those students who are attending Tecumseh Vista Academy will be allowed to remain. Future siblings will follow the new boundary to be implemented as of September 2014.

Principals and committee members were available at respective school tables set up in the back of the gym.

5. Closing Comments and Adjournment:

Members of the audience left after speaking with the various he meeting adjourned at 8 p.m.

- To address empty student spaces, renewal needs, capacity challenges, FCI (Facility Condition Index) and aging infrastructure.
- GECSDB has over 7,000 empty student spaces and a deficit of \$5.2 million. Many boards throughout the province are facing the same challenges. Funding is based on student enrolment . The enrolment in Ontario continues to decline, therefore funding continues to decrease.
- The Tecumseh Family has 4 schools operating with 4 different grade structures.
- We understand that status quo is not an option and we need to use our resources in the most efficient and effective manner possible.

The Tecumseh Family of Schools PARC values our students and their families and strives to:

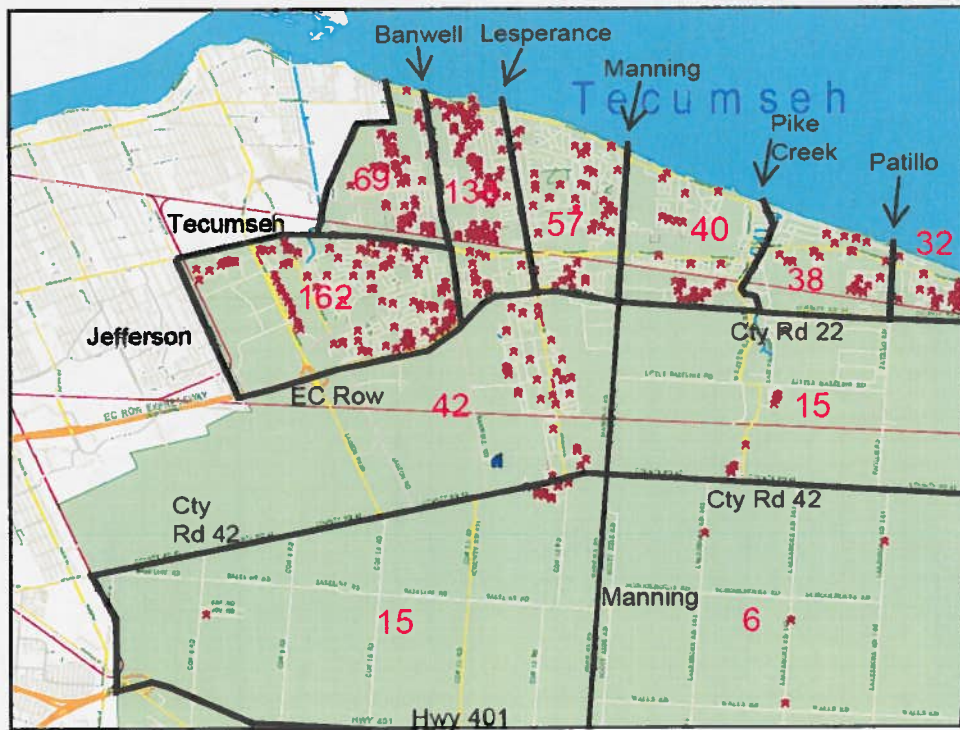
- Maintain a dual track secondary school at Tecumseh Vista Academy

Final Recommendations

a) Close Victoria Public School in 2014 and transition students to AV Graham School creating a JK- grade 8 school.
Adjust Tecumseh Vista's French Immersion western boundary to west of Banwell Rd., North of E.C. Row; transition affected students to attend a dual track program at Forest Glade School for September 2014

Students attending Tecumseh Vista Academy as of the 2013-2014 school year will be granted a limited exception to remain at Tecumseh Vista Academy.

Adjust Tecumseh Vista Secondary French Immersion western boundary to bring it into line with the Elementary French Immersion boundary

b) Close Victoria Public School in 2014 and transition students to AV Graham School creating a JK- grade 8 school.
Adjust Tecumseh Vista's French Immersion western boundary to west of Banwell Rd., North of E.C. Row; transition affected students to attend a dual track program at Forest Glade School for September 2014;
The Board pursues Capital Funding from the Ministry of Education and if approved closes DM Eagle upon;
Priority #1 – the completion of a new school in the North Shore and DM Eagle students will be transitioned to the new dual track JK-8 grade school; or
Priority #2 – the completion of an addition to AV Graham Public School to accommodate DM Eagle students

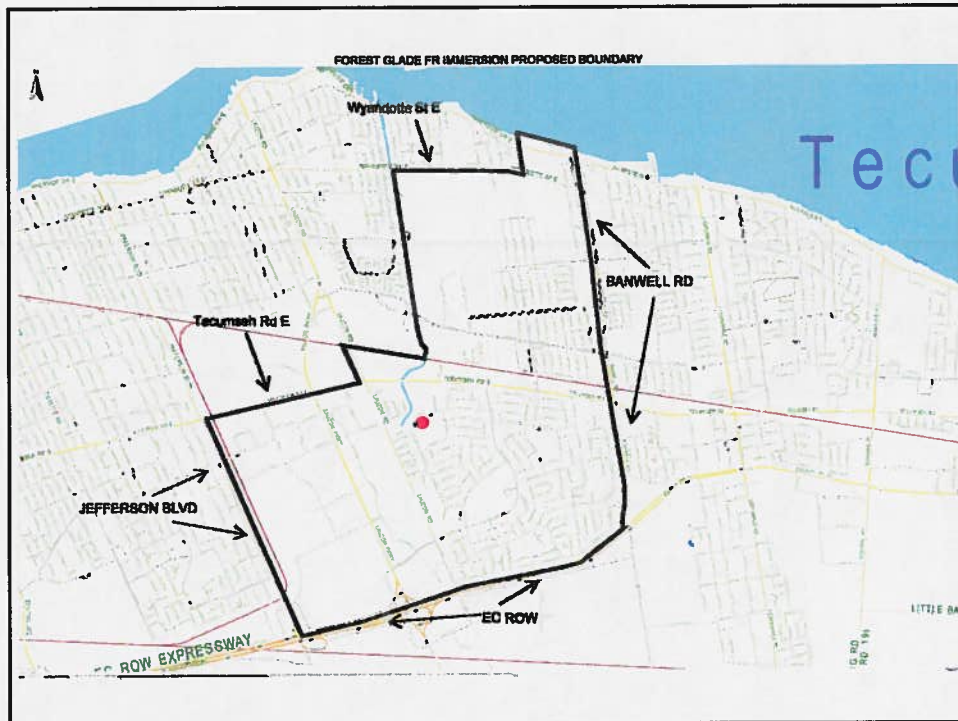

FOREST GLADE FRENCH IMMERSION PROPOSED BOUNDARY

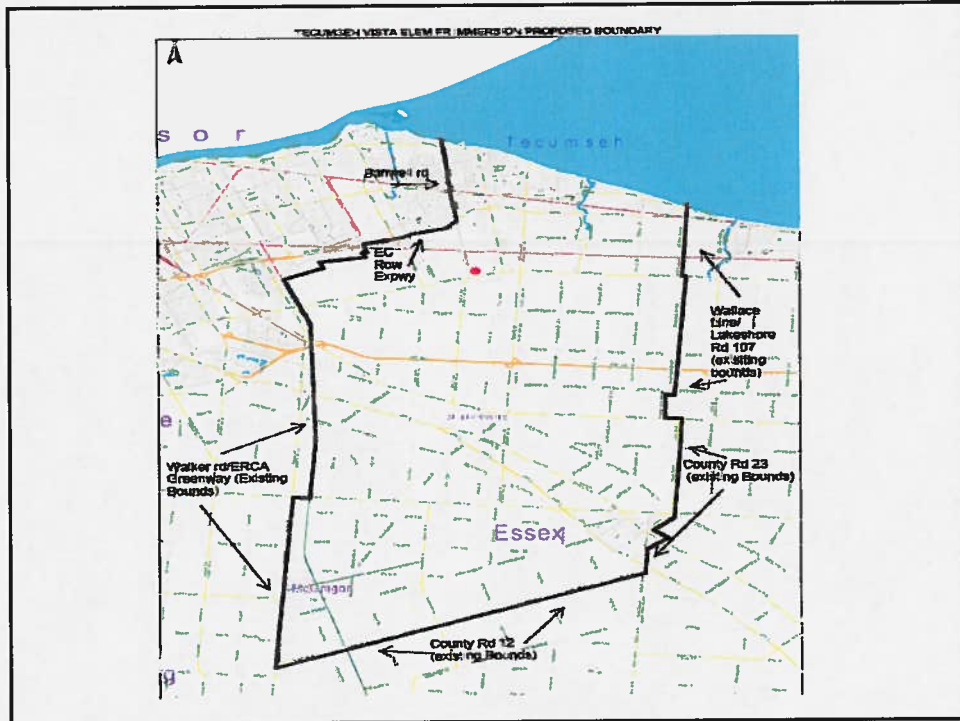
- **North:** Starting from Tecumseh Rd E & Jefferson Blvd, east along Tecumseh Rd, north along Lauzon (both sides included) to the VIA tracks, east to Little River (actual river), north to Wyandotte St E. Along Wyandotte St E to Lublin (right of way) north to Lake St Clair
- **East:** Banwell Rd (Both sides not included) south to EC Row Expwy
- **South:** EC Row Expwy
- **West:** Jefferson Blvd



Proposed Boundary Adjustment

TECUMSEH VISTA ELEMENTARY FRENCH IMMERSION PROPOSED BOUNDARY

- **North:** Lake St Clair from Banwell Rd East to Wallace Line Rd
- **East:** A line east of Wallace Line Rd south to County Rd 42 to a line east of Lakeshore Rd 107 south to North Rear Rd, west to Pleasant Park Side Rd, south to County Rd 46, east to County Rd 23, South to County Rd 8, along County Rd 23 (both sides included) to County Rd 12.
- **South:** County Rd 12 from County Rd 23 to Walker Rd.
- **West:** Walker Rd north to County Rd 8, east to ERCA Greenway (abandoned railway) north to the former Windsor municipal boundary, following this boundary north of the airport lands, to Jefferson north to EC Row Expwy. Head east along EC Row Expwy to Banwell Rd, north along Banwell Rd (both sides included) to Lake St Clair.
