- Provide academic supports to elementary and secondary students with learning difficulties in the area of language and math.
- Provide support to teachers in a consultative model or work directly with students for blocks of time, either in the classroom environment or in an alternative environment.
- Provide consultation and resource support to classroom teachers to ensure students are receiving appropriate accommodations and differentiated instruction within the classroom.

Tiered Learning Support

Tier 1:

• Informal supports and consultation with classroom teacher assisting with instructional strategies for differentiated instruction, accommodations and flexible groupings within the classroom.

Tier 2:

- Providing short term strategic assistance and progress monitoring.
- Collaborating with teachers regarding student's needs and strategies.
- Delivery of the Empower Program.
- Continue to assist with instructional strategies for differentiated instruction, accommodations and flexible groupings within the classroom.

Tier 3

- Active, supportive programming and sharing responsibility for student achievement through regularly scheduled intervention and progress monitoring.
- Ongoing consultation with parents and teachers in the areas of programming supports and services.

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
