- ALWAYS get approval from a guidance counsellor beforehand if uncertain
- Students with 22 or more credits in September 2025 will graduate in June 2026; those without will develop a plan with their counsellor

A) Process:

On-line Applications:

OPENS EARLY OCTOBER College - www.ontariocolleges.ca

- Need OEN which is the number found beside your name on any of your report cards (it is different than your student number)
- Cost is \$150 for 5 choices; no more than 3 choices at any one college, list in order of preference

University - www.ouac.on.ca OPENS LATE SEPTEMBER

- Need OEN which is the number found beside your name on any of your report cards (it is different than your student number)
- Cost is \$156 for 3 choices; no more than 3 choices at any one university, \$50 for each

It is your responsibility to confirm on both of these websites that the marks and courses listed are current and correct, even after you have applied (e.g mid-term and final marks each semester). Report any discrepancies to Guidance.

Students will be given equal consideration for all programs applied to if application payment is

OCAS (College) - February 1, 2026 - EQUAL CONSIDERATION DATE OUAC (University) - JANUARY 15, 2026 - EQUAL CONSIDERATION DATE

Don't wait until the last minute, as the high volume of applications may delay the processing of your application in a timely fashion.

College - OSSD and any required courses University - OSSD, 6 4U/4M courses and any required courses

- Coop does not count as a 4U/4M course
- Some universities may limit the number of 4M courses that they will accept
- Some universities may penalize grades earned for repeat and summer school courses
- Admission averages are based on top 6 4U/4M courses (some universities may include required courses in average or some (e.g. UWindsor) may calculate a second program average - check with each individual university and program)




