INSTRUCTIONS

This registration package is for Grade 8 students who are IN-DISTRICT (i.e. home residence is located within the buskids boundary, see below to locate your HOME school, if unsure) for Sandwich Secondary School and fall into one of the following three categories:

- are currently enrolled in a Catholic elementary school (either English or French)
- · are currently enrolled in a Private school
- currently enrolled in a school board outside Windsor-Essex but are relocating to a residence within the Sandwich Secondary School district

To locate your home school based on your residency go to www.buskids.ca and click on the BUS PLANNER WEB button at the top right-hand corner... click on Can I Ride a Bus?... next enter your address... the Board is Greater Essex County DSB... enter your child's grade. If your child is in French Immersion, please indicate accordingly in program area.

- 1. Follow the Registration Checklist provided and return all requested documentation in your registration package.
- 2. Your completed online registration will be printed in the Student Services office when your registration package is returned. You will be asked to sign or initial all pages requiring a parental signature.
- 3. If your child has a current IEP at their elementary school, include a copy with the registration package.
- 4. Ensure that your child's name is printed at the top of each page of the package.
- 5. Place all your paperwork in this blue folder.

The deadline to return the registration package is **Friday, February 23rd, 2024 at 3 pm**. Please drop off at the Student Services office located at the roundabout entrance, first office on the right.

Packages can be returned during normal business hours from Monday, February 12 - Friday, February 23, 2024 between 8 am - 3 pm.

Online Learning Graduation Requirement

Students are required to earn two online learning (eLearning) credits to graduate from secondary school, beginning with students who entered Grade 9 in the 2020-21 school year.

The graduation requirement is intended to support students in developing familiarity and comfort with working and learning in a fully online environment, as well as developing digital literacy and other important transferable skills that will help prepare them for success after graduation and in all aspects of their lives.

Meeting the online learning graduation requirement will not pose a barrier to graduation for students. As with all learning, students taking e-Learning courses will have access to the supports they need through their school including special education, guidance and services for English Language Learners. If the student has an Individual Education Plan, the plan will be shared, when appropriate, with an educator instructing an online course delivered by another publicly funded school board, with the necessary consent.

Parents/guardians may choose at any time to opt their child out of the mandatory eLearning courses required for graduation. Students 18 years of age or older or students who are 16 or 17 years of age and have withdrawn from parental control may also opt out of the graduation requirement at any time. Students and parents/guardians may choose to opt back into the e-Learning graduation requirement at any time if they change their decision. The e-Learning courses that GECDSB schools offer will be available during the course selection process in myBlueprint.

If you have decided now to opt out your child or yourself (18 years of age or older or student who is 16 or 17 years of age and has withdrawn from parental control), please complete and submit the following form to your school.
