FOR MEDIA

- Create your portfolio
- Put together a collection of photos, digital manipulations, video, graphic design, and or artwork that
 represents your strongest work. The portfolio does not have to have each of the areas identified. If all
 you have is artwork, then bring in your strongest work.

TIPS ON PICKING THE WORK FOR THE PORTFOLIO

- Select Photos that are in focus, have good exposure, interesting composition
- Select works that demonstrates creativity
- · Select work that demonstrates your digital manipulation and other digital skills
- Your portfolio should be organized in a folder, presentation binder, or clearly labeled in a folder on a USB Drive.
- If you have it include work that has been digitally produced.
