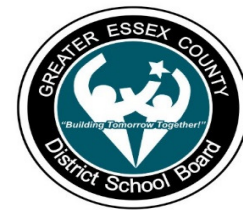

Immigration papers or proof of citizenship. Complete high school transcript. Any additional post secondary documents.
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New students are only allowed to enroll in one course. Students who have successfully completed a course may register for two courses. Students who have dropped courses may only enroll in one course.
1st Day of Class Bring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Registration receipt. \$50.00 book deposit (cash only). This includes all students, 3rd party agencies are to be dealt with by student.
