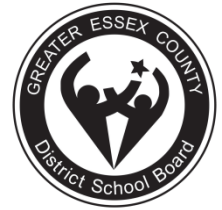

Athletic Code of Conduct

Congratulations on being selected to represent A.V. Graham on a school team.

Parent/guardian, please review each of the following points with your son or daughter and sign below indicating you have read and understand the Athletic Code of Conduct.

- Coaches make all decisions regarding all teams and student athletes. Playing time will be the decision of the coaches and will not be discussed during the game.
- Practices are very important. Prior notice of missing a practice is necessary unless it is an unexpected illness.
- Each student athlete is expected to be a team player and be supportive of all other team members, consistently demonstrating courtesy and respect for others.
- It is important that student athletes maintain acceptable levels of academic achievement, effort, behaviour and attitude. Concerns by any staff member may result in that student being suspended from the team.

Students who are absent on the school day in which a practice, game or tournament takes place, will not be eligible to participate on that school day unless previous arrangements have been made with the coach.

- The ability and judgment of the referee is not to be questioned by any student athlete or parent. Any displays of disrespect in this area may result in that athlete's removal from the game and also from the team.
- Implied in this code of conduct is an expected level of conduct for the families of the athletes as they come to watch the competition. Their conduct as spectators should be exemplary and their involvement in the team should not in any way be intrusive.
- A parent must agree to pick up the student athlete on time from all practices and games or make appropriate arrangements.
- Siblings of players are welcome to attend games only if parents are there to supervise their children. Coaches are working with the athletes and therefore not able to supervise siblings.

Playing time may not be equal among all team members depending on the game, situation and skill level. This decision will be made at the sole discretion of the coaches and I will respect their decision. I agree to adhere to the EDESSA Code of Conduct for sportsmanship and respect of all coaches and referees, as they are volunteering their time for the sole benefit of the students.
