



School Climate Survey 2017

The purpose of the school climate survey is to strengthen our system and our individual schools by celebrating our strengths, acknowledging our weaknesses and planning the next steps to ensure positive learning and working environments for everyone.

Data for the student and parent surveys conducted in the Winter of 2017 indicates:

- *Majority of students feel safe or very safe at school*
- *A majority of the respondents feel that Eastwood is a welcoming place where students feel they have adults that they can go talk to.*
- *A significantly high number of students responded to not being bullied/harassed due to race, ethnicity or culture in the past 4 weeks.*
- *A large percentage of Eastwood students reported that they believe that healthy eating, sleep and physical activity is important to their well-being. A significantly high number of students also responded to maintaining several healthy well-being practices such as proper eating habits, appropriate sleep and involved in physical fitness.*

- *The survey results demonstrate a need to review:*
 - *Students need to continue to understand the role of the bystander and how bystanders can support victims*
 - *Awareness of minorities need to be specifically taught to students*

- *As a result of the school climate survey we will:*
 - *Empowering students to understand the role of the bystander and how they can support victims and reduce bullying*
 - *Continue to purchase resources and bring in guest speakers that reflect diverse communities*
