

Adding Visual Effects

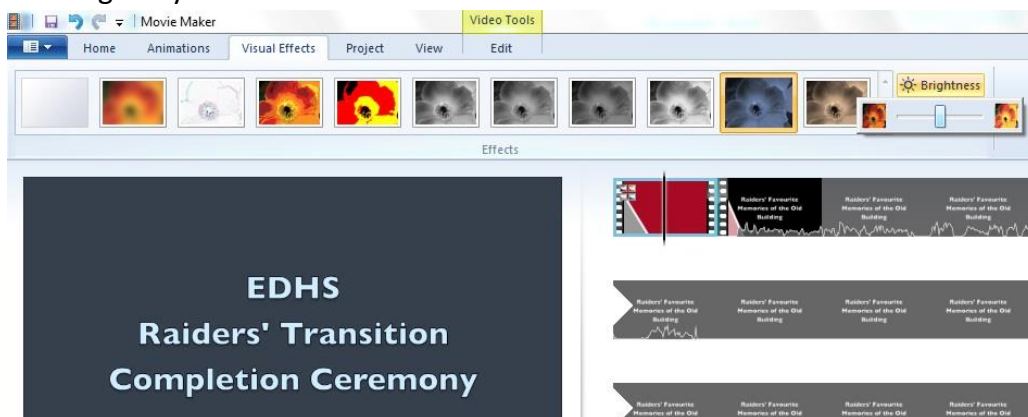
The purpose of this tutorial is to teach you how to add your own special touches to make your movies look distinctive and professional. By adding transitions and effects, you can make sure that your movie flows nicely from one scene to the next.

Adding Visual Effects:

1. Select the video in your storyboard you want the effect to be added to. Navigate to the “Visual Effects” tab.



2. From here you can view a large assortment of different visual effects and you can choose whichever ones you want. All of these were created by Microsoft and they are in a default setting. If you select a visual effects, it will play a preview for you. If you want the same visual effect applied to each video, click the “Apply to All” option.
3. To customize how dark or bright you want the effect to appear, you can change the brightness of it. Select the “Brightness” button and a drop down menu will appear with a sliding bar you can customize with.



Removing a Visual Effect:

1. Select the video you want the visual effect removed from.
2. In the effects panel under the “Visual Effects” tab, select the very first effect that appears in the panel. This effect is a blank effect, which means no transitions will appear in your selected video.
