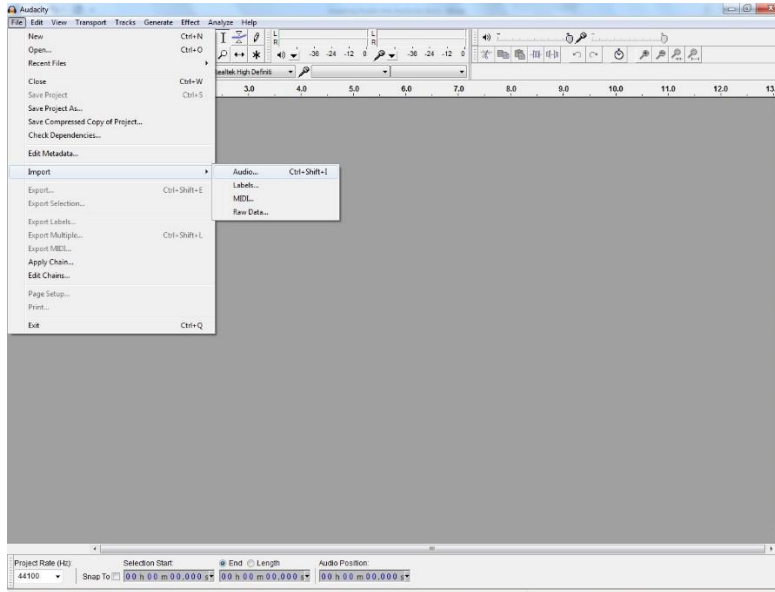


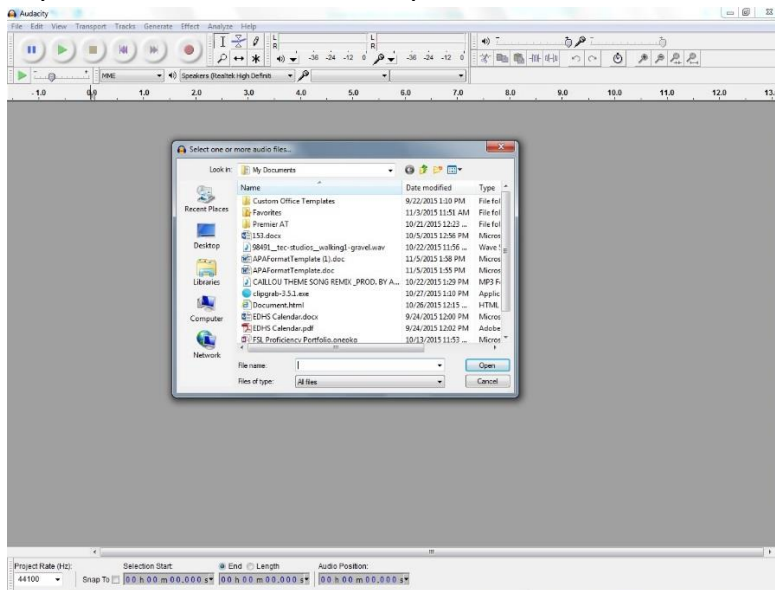
# Inserting Audio into Audacity

The purpose of this tutorial is to demonstrate how you can insert your own audio files to create a personalized Audacity project. There are an assortment of different formats of audio that Audacity supports: WAV, AIFF, PCM, MP2, MP3, and FLAC.

1. Open the program Audacity. From here, navigate to the “File” tab in the top left-hand corner, and click “Import”. In the drop down menu that appears, select “Audio...”. A quicker way to do this is hold (CTRL + SHIFT + i) on your keyboard.



2. A window with your documents will pop-up. From here you can choose your desired files to import into the program. To select multiple files at once, hold CTRL on your keyboard and click on the files you want.



- Your desired files will appear in the grey portion of the screen. The imported audio files are now considered “audio tracks”. These tracks are now enabled for editing.
