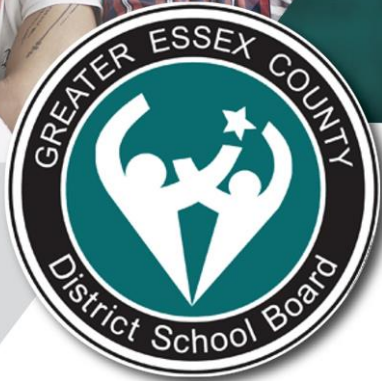




SCHOOL CLIMATE

SURVEY



The purpose of the school climate survey is to strengthen our system and our individual schools by celebrating our strengths, acknowledging our weaknesses and planning the next steps to promote safe, inclusive, healthy, and respectful learning environments.

DATA FROM THE STUDENT AND COMMUNITY SURVEYS

CONDUCTED IN THE WINTER OF 2019 INDICATES:

- 88% of students feel welcome at school
- Almost all parents feel welcome at our school
- 70% of students feel they have a caring adult to go to at school if they need help
- 40% of students indicated that if needed they would ask for mental health help at school
- 97% of students use a mobile tech device
- 74% of students are on technology after school (games, videos, texting, etc.) at least 3 hours or more per day



THE SURVEY RESULTS DEMONSTRATE A NEED TO REVIEW:

- the need to review how we promote student services
- students perception of healthy living choices
- Communication with students through social media



AS A RESULT OF THE SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY WE WILL:

- Survey students on how to provide them with student services information
- Continue to explore and implement the use of social media in communicating events and activities with students, parents, and the community
- Educate students on the importance of a healthy lifestyle with respect to exercise, sleep, nutrition, and disconnecting devices.
