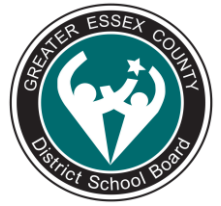

OUT OF DISTRICT - JK – Gr. 8

Marlborough Public School is an OPEN BOUNDARY school; however, you must apply to the board of education in order to attend our school if you do not live within our boundaries.

“Elementary Out of District Applications must be received by the Principal of the receiving school by May 1st for September of the same year. This deadline is strictly enforced.

If you are considering an application for your child(ren) to attend a school as out of district student(s) for the 2018-2019 school year, please ensure that your application is completed and submitted to the principal by May 1, 2018.

A sibling of a student who has already been approved to attend an out of district school must apply in the usual manner with no guarantee of acceptance.

Please understand that applying for Out of District at any time may be denied based on open vs. closed boundary schools, potential Program and Accommodation Reviews, boundary studies, or capacity challenges, etc. Completion of the form does not guarantee placement at a requested out of district school. The Superintendent responsible for Accommodations makes the final decision and you will be officially advised, by letter, whether or not the application is approved.”

Lost and Found

Items found in the school after hours are placed in the lockers across from the Boys washroom on the main floor. If your child is missing an article of clothing, a lunch bag, mittens, etc., please have them look in the Lost and Found lockers.

At the end of every other month, all items in the Lost and Found Lockers are displayed in the main hallway, and classes are walked past to collect items that belong to them.

Please help us to return items to their rightful owners by writing their names in lunchbags, coats, boots, etc. Items not claimed after all students have had the chance to go past the displayed items are either donated to a local charity or discarded as the case may be. Parents are always welcome to come and look through the Lost and Found.

PLEASE NOTE – at times students bring home items that do not belong to them – if this is the case, PLEASE return the item to the school. Guaranteed, someone is looking for that item.
