



Sandwich West PS School Climate Survey 2015

The purpose of the school climate survey is to strengthen our system and our individual schools by celebrating our strengths, acknowledging our weaknesses and planning the next steps to ensure positive learning and working environments for everyone.

Data from the student and parent surveys conducted in the Spring of 2015 indicates:

- *Students in grades 4-8 feel that Sandwich West Public School is a welcoming place and they report that they enjoy being at school*
- *A large majority of our students reported that they feel safe in their classrooms*
- *A large majority of our parents reported that their children's academic needs are being met and that they feel that Sandwich West is an excellent learning environment*

The survey results demonstrate a need to review:

- *Pathway planning for students regarding planning for the transition to highschool*
- *Communication regarding strategies that are put into place to address bullying*

As a result of the school climate survey we will:

- *Continue to provide a variety of different avenues for students to celebrate their individual strengths and uniqueness*
- *Continue to work on elementary to secondary school transition planning for students, providing them with information about course selection and a wide range of post-secondary pathways*
