You'll log in with the same userID and password you use to get onto school computers.

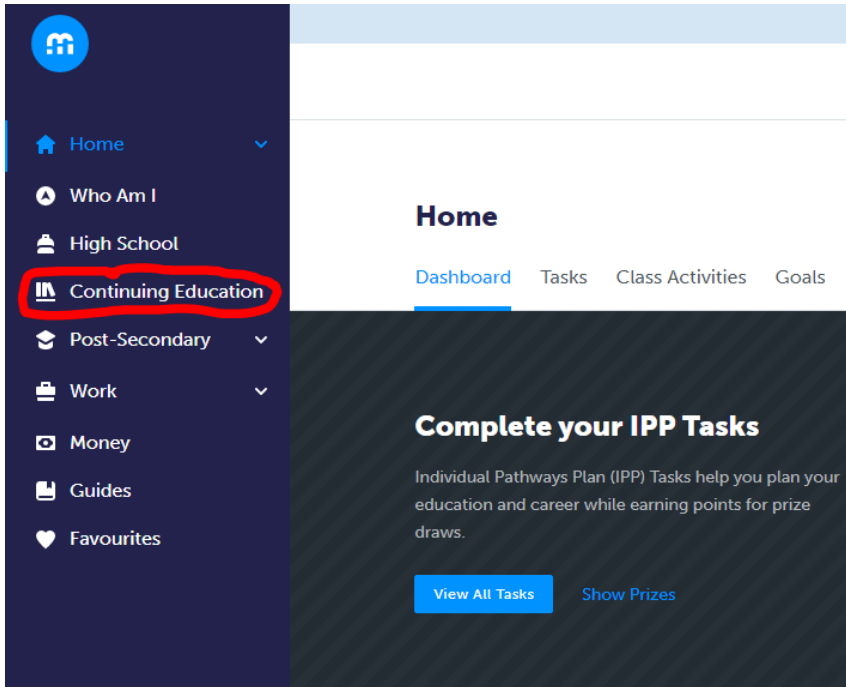

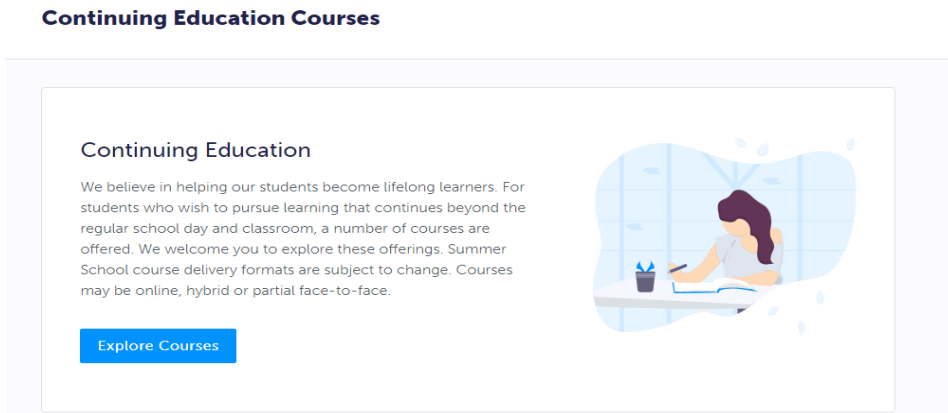


Once in myBlueprint, you'll follow these prompts to select the course for Reaching Ahead.
