SUBJECT: Community Planning and Partnerships - Report on Potential Spaces Available

#### AIM:

To inform the Board of potential unused spaces that are available for cost recovery/lease in compliance with Policy and Regulation Community Planning and Partnerships P-BA-30 and R-BA-30.

In compliance with the policy and regulation, the Board must annually hold a public meeting and notify certain organizations and groups of any unused space suitable for third party use, on a cost recovery basis, that is expected to be available for a number of years. The criteria for availability are that a school has, for two years or more, been operating at 60% or less of on the ground capacity and/or has 200 or more unused pupil places.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The COVID-19 pandemic has significantly impacted community partnerships, rentals and community use of schools during the current school year. Enhanced health and safety protocols mandated by the Ministry of Education (the "Ministry") to support the safe re-opening of schools, local public health unit school closure orders and Ministry directives requiring the transition to on-line learnings for many of the Board's students required the Board to pause community use of its facilities for the 2020/21 school year. The Board will continue to monitor the Province of Ontario's *Roadmap to Reopen* to inform determinations on the timing for reopening school facilities for community use.

In conjunction with the Board's policy and regulation, a Community Planning and Partnership Meeting was held virtually on December 3, 2020. Invitations were emailed to the list of entities in Attachment 1. The public meeting was advertised through the local media, information was posted on the Board's website and an email was sent to the organizations listed in Attachment 1. The information session provided municipalities and community partners with an opportunity to review the list of schools with available space, while also providing an overview of surplus space, aging infrastructure and the Board's commitment to fiscal responsibility.
