Choosing A Topic

Follow these steps to help you decide on a topic for your report.

1. Write the assignment in your own words.

2. Did your teacher give you a specific topic?

Example: Write a report about polar bears.

If you have been given a specific assignment, then you do not need to do anything else to choose a topic. You must write a report about the topic your teacher has chosen.

3. Did your teacher give you a general topic?

Example: Write a report about an area of science that interests you.

This type of assignment lets you choose any science topic you want to write about. It also requires that you to think about all the things that fit the category. It might be helpful to list your ideas here.
