PD Update – February 2021

- Boardmaker: Expedition Education and Activities to Go Expedition Education and Activities to Go. This workshop will teach you how to implement

- Behaviour Management Systems Recertification
 Staff will complete their recertification process with an online model reinforcing emphasis on

In this presentation, staff will look at the "why" behind common challenging behaviours (aggression, stereotypy, non-compliance, disruption, etc.) seen in the classroom setting.

- Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) This presentation will identify the areas most impacted by FASD and how we can support students with FASD in the classroom and school setting.
