CO-OP - Is it in your future?

Walkerville Collegiate Institute offers Cooperative Education placements to students in grade 11/12.

Students will:

- Gain valuable work experience.
- Gain hours which can be put towards an apprenticeship through the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program.
- · Earn secondary school credits.
- Develop lifelong employment skills.
- Meet individuals who can potentially shape their future.
- Potentially receive paid employment opportunities.
- Can be used toward SHSM designation.

Creating Opportunities through Co-Op, DCO3O, Grade 11, Open

- Incorporates and engages students into the community.
- Focus is on developing skills and knowledge through experience in the community.
- Students learn about safety as well as develop research, decision making and leadership skills.
- Students will create a learning plan that meets their interests and needs.







GUIDANCE COURSES

GLC2OH: Career Studies (0.5 credit)

This course gives students the opportunity to develop the skills, knowledge and habits that will support them in their education and career planning.

Students will learn about:

- Global work trends
- Transferable skills
- Adapting in the workplace
- Postsecondary options
- Setting goals
- Creating plans
- Personal financial management

GLS1OC: Learning Strategies

This course focuses on learning strategies to help students become better, more independent learners.

Students will learn to develop and apply:

- Literacy and numeracy skills
- Personal management skills
- Interpersonal and teamwork skills

This course is geared towards students in the de-streamed pathway, who are working towards the Level 3 Provincial standard.
